- A student is not eligible to register for the thesis (to be written in English) unless he/she has successfully passed %50 of the courses. With the cooperation of the student supervisor, each candidate is required to publish a minimum of one research paper relates to his/her master thesis in peer-reviewed law journal.
- To be able to register for thesis, the student must complete the required procedures: selecting a supervisor, selecting a thesis supervisor and title, preparing the thesis proposal, presenting it to the committee, and obtaining final approval from Graduate Studies. Upon approval, the initial 3 credit hours are automatically registered by Graduate Studies..
- The student may then register the remaining hours (3 or 6) in the following semester.
- If all thesis hours are completed without submitting the thesis, the student must register for 0 credit hours.
